## A. <u>Department Head Updates</u>

Chief Jeremy Hall presented stats for the month of February. Chief Hall stated that other staff were being radar certified and staff were updating their In-Service training. Chief Hall informed the Board that he continues to have classes with Churches. Chief Hall stated that plans are being made pertaining to the Covid-19. Chief Hall informed the Board that there was no change in the vehicle situation. (Reference # 5)

Mike Collins Recreation Director informed the Board that the Recreation Board would be meeting next week and that travel ball is hurting our recreation program. Registration completed for baseball, softball and adult softball will begin next week. Mr. Collins stated that the park will be active on Mondays, Tuesdays and Thursdays. Mr. Collins updated the Board that Amy Johnson is working with Campbell students to paint and work on designs on the buildings.
